Dear Parents,

Please find attached a letter from your son/daughter's Head of Division regarding the arrangements for the exam results days. Weather permitting, we intend to hand out results outside the school building. If the weather is inclement, we will open the auditorium doors closest to the main car park for access to results tables in the auditorium.

Many schools will either have a 'virtual' results day posting all results electronically, or will stagger collection times. However, we felt that it was important to try to make the results days as normal as possible here at Beechwood, to reward students and parents for their resilience and co-operation during these very difficult past months.

We will need to ensure that COVID-19 precautions are followed, so I would urge you to discuss the day with your son/daughter in view of the following:

- Students and parents should continue to respect social distancing whilst on the school site. This includes being aware of their proximity to other students and parents when collecting results, and following staff guidance for queuing and collection.
- Students and parents should not engage with different household social hugs or group selfies.
- Students and parents should follow marked entry and exit instructions.
- We will need to limit the number of visitors to the school, so we would ask parents to be mindful of this, and staff instructions as to whether we will need to stagger the collection of results at busy times on the results day mornings.
- It is very important that people with symptoms of or a positive COVID-19 test and their household members stay at home. Staying at home will help prevent the spread of the virus to family, friends, the wider community, and particularly those who are vulnerable.

I look forward to seeing as many of you as possible on the relevant results day from 8am.
